Soft White Winter Wheat

AP700 CL is the most broadly adapted *CLEARFIELD wheat in the Pacific Northwest. AP700 CL has a very good disease package, making it feasible in recrop situations.

Soft White Winter Wheat

PALOMINO

Hard White Winter Wheat

If you are looking to diversify your portfolio, Palomino is your best hard white winter wheat option following hard white spring wheats. Palomino has very good straw strength and is a high-protein variety, making it desirable under irrigation and in higher rainfall regions.

PALADIN

AgriPro Paladin is a high-yielding hard red winter wheat for high rainfall regions and under irrigation. AgriPro Paladin has excellent straw strength and test weight plus high protein and end-use quality.

Legion has shown very good winter hardiness and emergence in strip trials side-by-side with Eltan in the Ritzville area. Legion also has adult plant tolerance to stripe rust and is moderately tolerant to strawbreaker foot rot.
